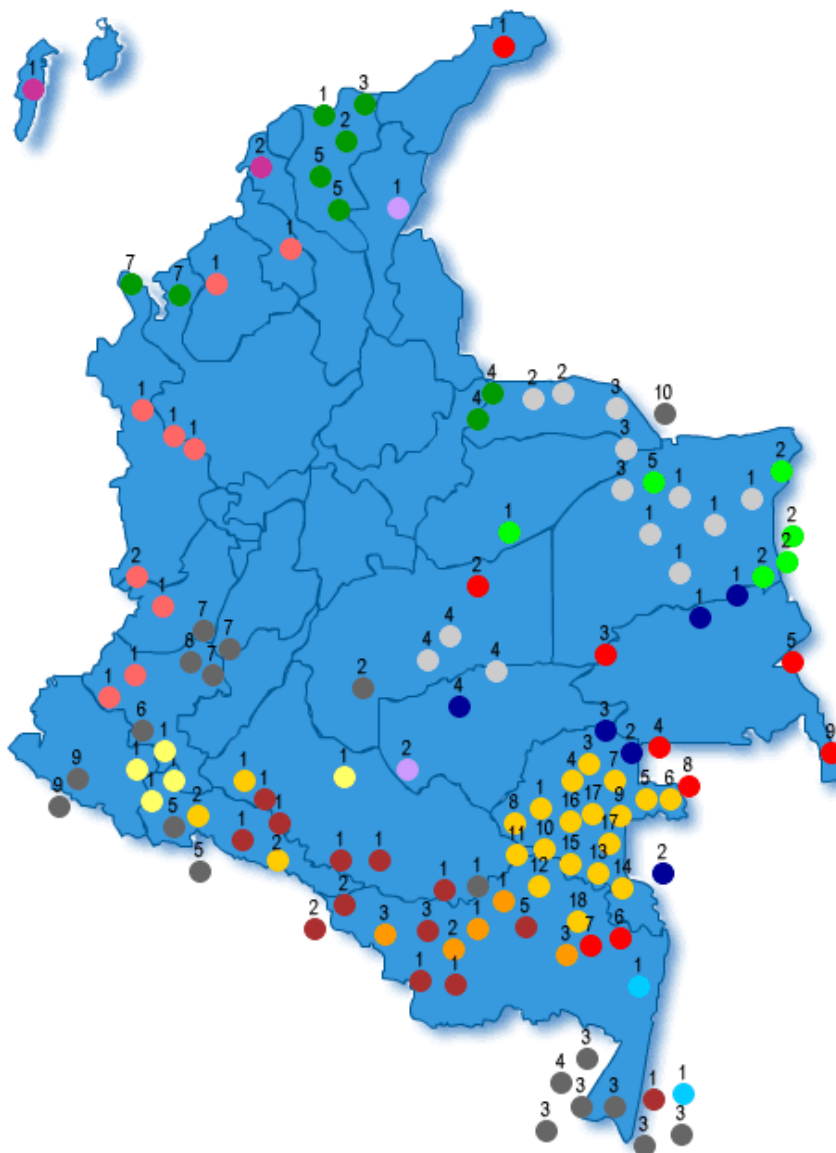

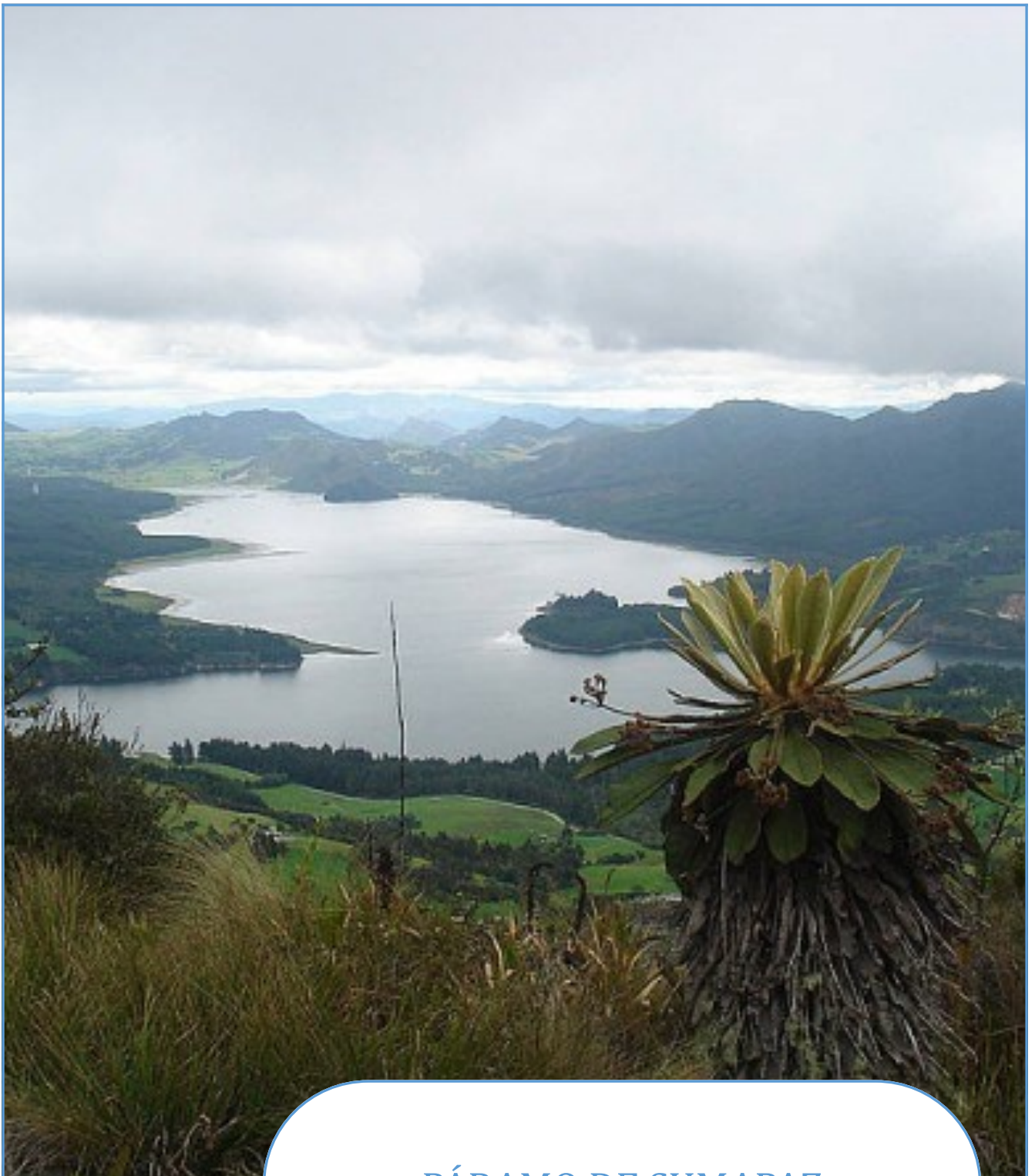

## PÁRAMO DE SUMAPAZ

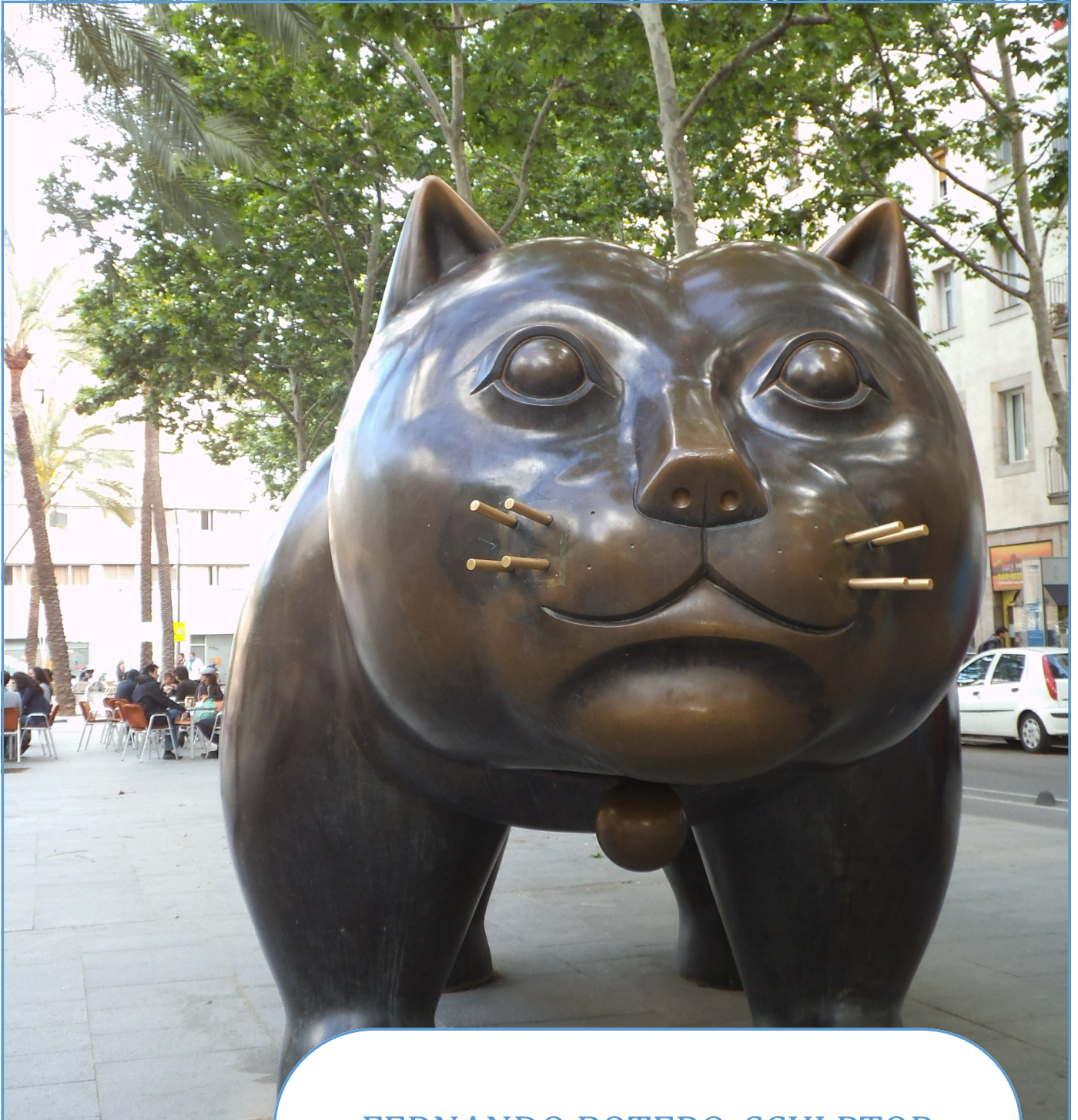

*Choose a famous art work or poem from that country that you find inspiring. Who is it by? When was it written? What is the title? Why did you choose it?*



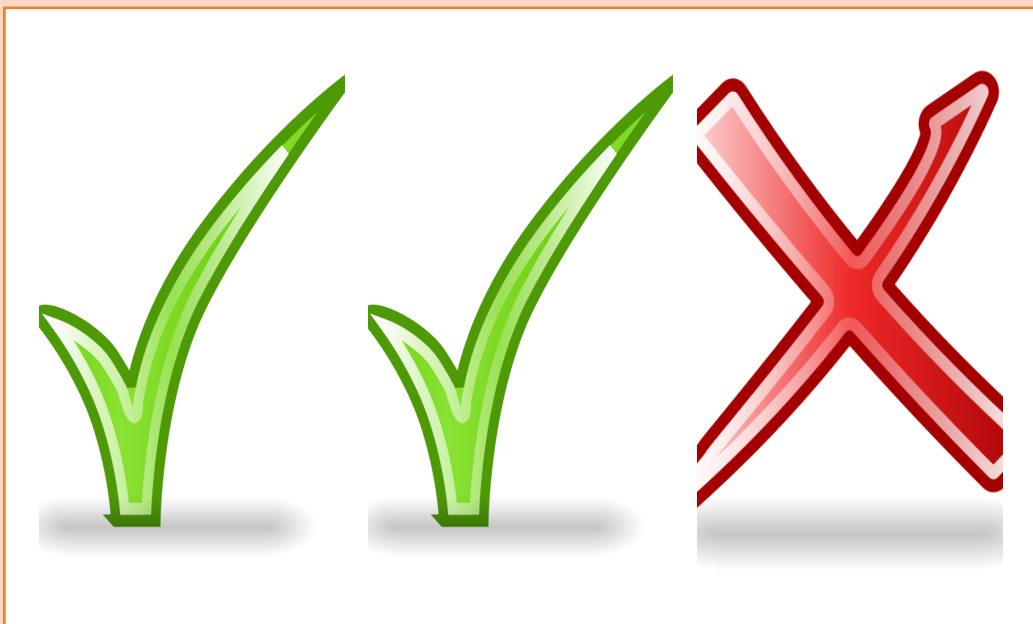
## Challenge—True or False
