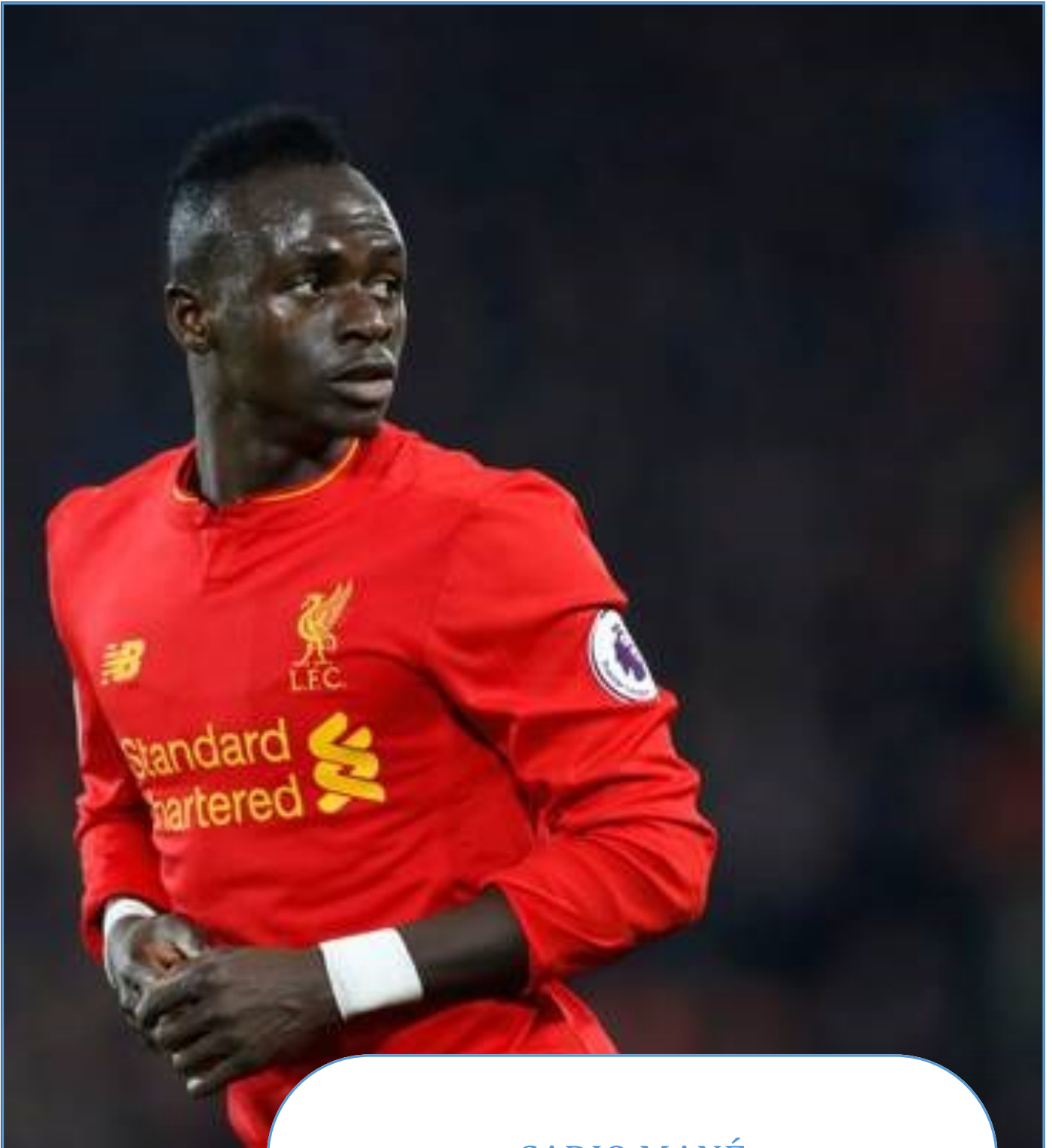

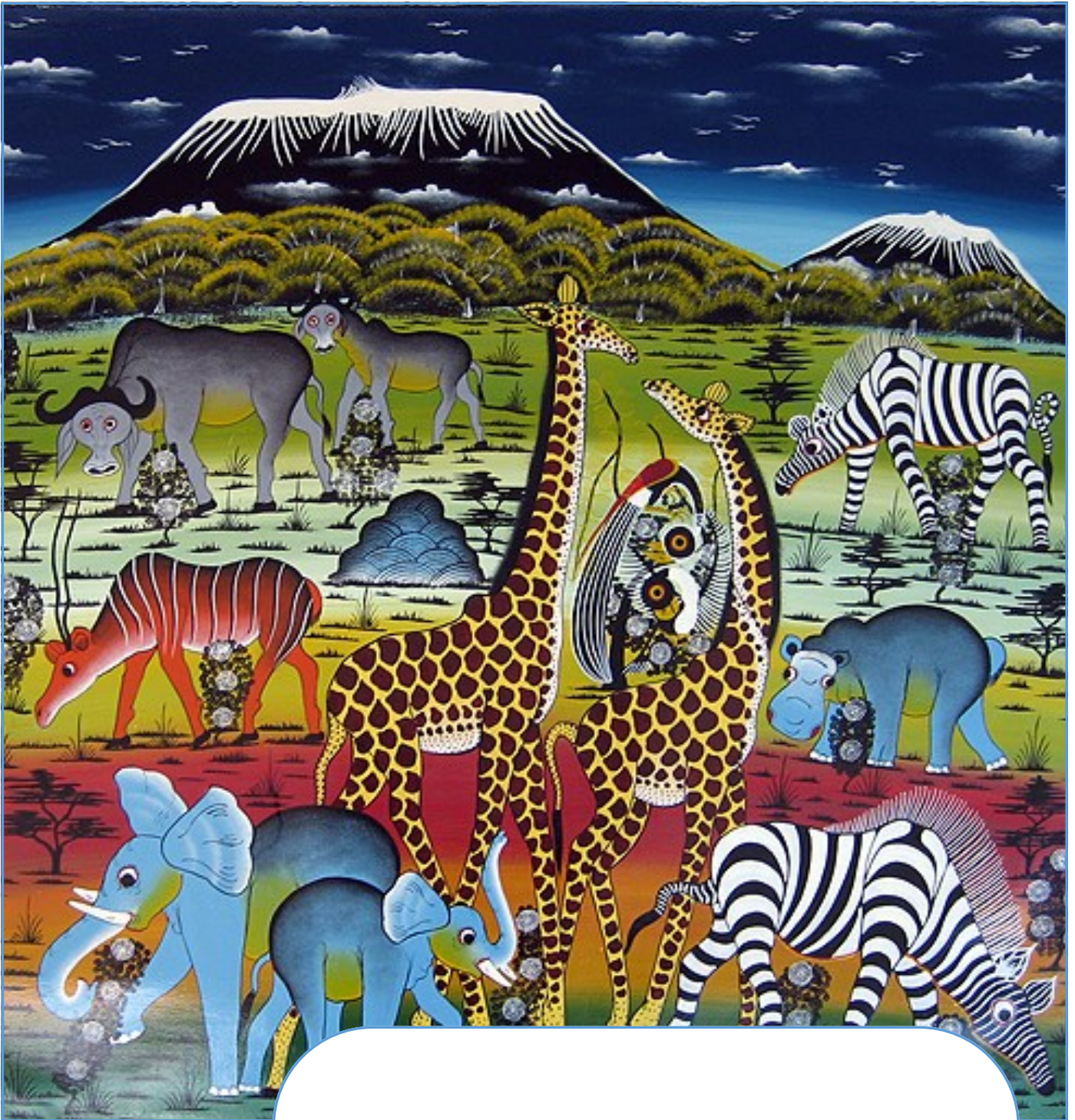
JOAL FADIOUT

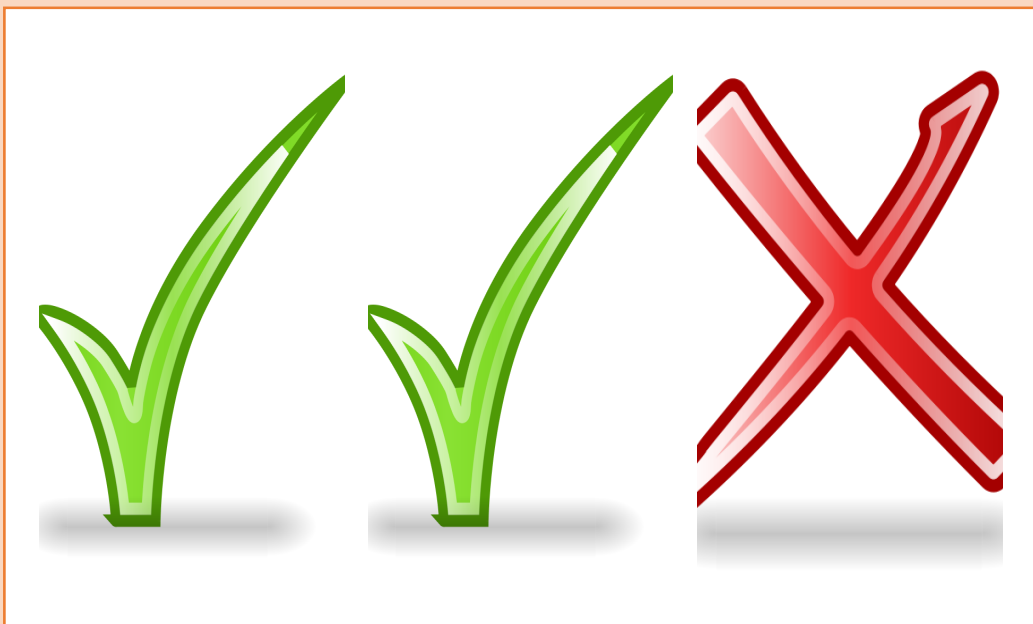
Choose a famous art work or poem from that country that you find inspiring. Who is it by? When was it written? What is the title? Why did you choose it?

Why is that country called what it is called?

It owes its name to the **Senegal** River, which borders it to the east and north. The name "**Senegal**" comes from the Wolof "Sunuu Gaal", which means "Our Boat".

The motto of that country?

Motto: "Un Peuple, Un But, Une Foi" ("*One People, One Goal, One Faith*")
