



YEAR 7 PROJECT TASK – DAILY LIFE IN TUDOR ENGLAND



Your task:

Over the next two weeks you will produce a factsheet about life in Tudor England. You must follow the instructions below to research, plan and produce your factsheet at home.

Instructions:

1. Your factsheet you **must include** a section on the following topics:

- Life in a Tudor Town
- Life in a Tudor Village

You must also **include *two*** sections of your own choice. You can choose any of the following topics: *Leisure in Tudor Times*, *Tudor Fashions*, *Crime and Punishment in Tudor England* or *Food in Tudor Times*.



2. Your factsheet must be produced on one sheet of A4 paper and cover **both** sides of the paper.
3. You must present your work **clearly** and **neatly**. It might help you to write some of the work out in rough first and then copy it up in neat. Try to use a combination of written work, pictures and diagrams. You can use coloured pens, pencil crayons or felt tips if you want to. You can produce your work on the computer as a word document, a powerpoint or a publisher document.
4. You will have **to carry out your own research**. You can use the Internet (there is a list of helpful websites below), library books and the knowledge organiser. When using your research to produce your factsheet you must not cut and paste or copy out sections of writing – all of your project should be written in your own words. However, you can cut and paste or photocopy pictures and put them into your work.
