Produce 100 words on why you are doing what you are doing

Work over photographs with pen or ink

Experiment with different media

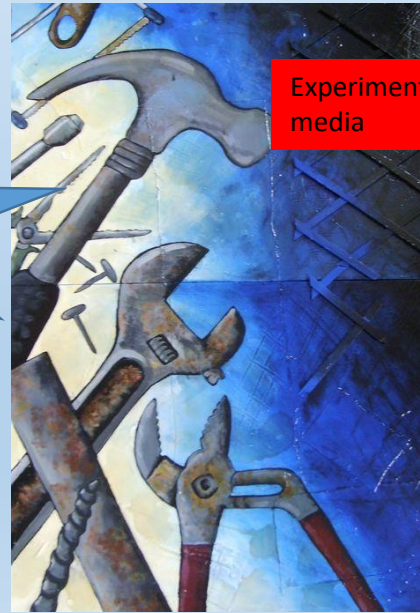
Be creative

Work from observation in different medias

Plan a final piece that uses the best of your preparation work. Use one of your photographs in the style of one of your artists Do a mock up ready to trace out in the exam. Leave 15 minutes in the exam to do an evaluation



CHECK LIST OF WHAT IS REQUIRED

This is the minimum work you need

1. Two artist research sheets to include
 - 3 coloured/ black and white print outs of artist work including titles and dates
 - Information about the artist in your own words to include why they produced work, in what media, dates they were born /died.
 - Why you like the work and how it is going to influence your work.
- 2 Two artist studies A3/A4 in different media, including one in the media used by the artist if possible.
- 3 12 photographs of your theme. Glued down with annotations.
- 4 2 observed from your photographs, A3/A4 in different media.
- 5 2 copies of your photographs in the style of two of the artists.
- 6 If you complete all the work, add more artists studies and artist research sheets.

Your exam is the week beginning 27th April

You need to know exactly what to do before you go into the exam

You need to draw out your piece and know what to do in the 10 hours.
